Melissa Smith (Ed.D., RID CI/CT, NAD V, EIPA 4.9) is an Associate Professor and Director of Palomar College's American Sign Language-English interpreting program in San Marcos, California. She holds doctoral and Master's degrees in Teaching and Learning from the University of California, San Diego and a baccalaureate degree in Spanish from San Diego State University. Her dissertation, *More than Meets the Eye: Revealing the Complexities of K-12 Interpreting* (2010), explores the practices and decisions of educational interpreters. Melissa received the honor of Interpreter Educator of the Year from Region V of the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf.
